**HAVE A GREAT SEASON**

Welcome to the start of year another cricket season. The following is just to let you know what is going on with Junior Cricket this year.....

### **Notices**

- All notices go into the Bully so please read the Junior Cricket section at the back.
- Also, we have a page on the [www.weipa.biz](http://www.weipa.biz) website, in the sports section, which we update regularly.

### **Clothing, Equipment, etc.**

- A white shirt and shorts/long pants must be worn.
- A wide brimmed hat is a must - it doesn't have to be white but players will not be allowed to play wearing caps.
- Sandshoes must be worn.
- The club has a supply of bats, gloves, pads and boxes which can be used. We recommend for both comfort and hygiene that two pairs of undies are worn if the club's boxes are used: The box simply slips in between the two pairs. Players are welcome to bring along their own gear, but please ensure that it is clearly marked.
- Drinking water is available on Saturday morning, but feel free to bring along a water bottle.

### **Starting Times**

- The younger age group play first at 7:45am on Saturday morning. Try to be there at least 10 minutes before that so we can start on time.
- The senior group play after the juniors and we ask them to be there at approximately 9:00am. This allows them to warm up in the nets and give the younger players some advice.

### **Training**

Training takes place on Thursday afternoons from 4:30 to 6pm at the cricket oval  
Remember sandshoes, a hat and a water bottle.

### **Canteen**

We generally do not do any fundraising, but do sell poppers, soft drinks and frozies on Saturday morning. All monies collected through these sales go directly back into buying equipment, trophies etc.

### **Junior Game Rules**

- To keep the game from drawing out too long and the younger players from losing interest, they play a shortened version of the game.
- The game comprises of each pair of batsmen batting four overs. They stay in if they lose their wicket but swap ends and have 3 runs deducted from their score.
- The field rotates after every over, giving every fielder the opportunity to bowl, field and wicket keep.

We look forward to seeing lots of parents at the field to support the players and maybe learn to score along the way.
